#End PJ Paralysis

Our hospital has joined the campaign 'End PJ Paralysis' which uses the simple idea of getting people out of bed and more active if they are able to. This is particularly important for our more elderly patients as 10 days of bed rest in hospital is the equivalent of 10 years muscle ageing and this loss of strength can make the difference can make the difference between dependence and independence. Ward volunteers can really help by encouraging patients to be mobile and also by engaging in activities on the ward, ideally ones that move patients into the ward day rooms or out of bed and into a chair. More information will be included in the monthly 'Adviser' magazine and there is also a poster up on our office noticeboard or just ask a member of the team.
