VOLUNTEER FORUM Tuesday 19th November at 16.00

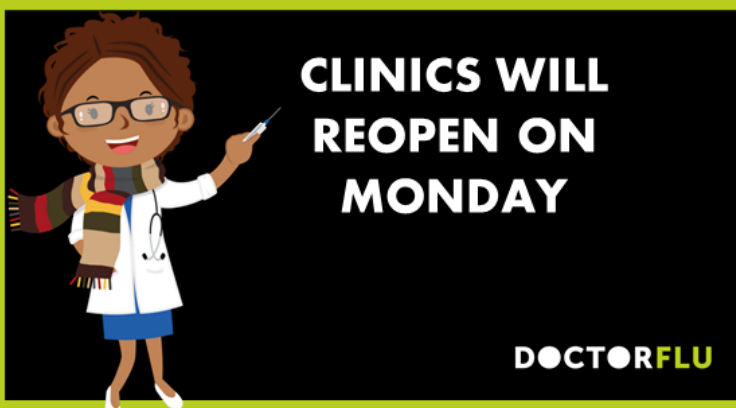
