Psychological Wellbeing Service

Thursday 10th Oct marked 'World Mental Health Day' and one of the support services offered is the *Psychological Wellbeing Service*.

This offers Cognitive Behavioural Therapy for anxiety (including panic and post-traumatic stress), depression, stress, obsessive compulsive disorder and low self-esteem. Options include personal therapy (face-to-face, telephone or through instant messaging), computerised CBT, guided self-help and telephone support.

This is a free NHS service for persons aged 17 years and older. There is no upper age limit and the service here is based at *Occupational Health and Wellbeing 1* day per week.
