## Appointment of new Chair for CUH

Baroness Sally Morgan (pictured below) has been appointed by the Council of Governors as the next Chair of CUH and will take up her role in January 2025.

Sally is currently the Deputy Chair of Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust and is also Master of Fitzwilliam College, University of Cambridge, sits on the University Council, and has been a Member of the House of Lords since 2001.

Sally will succeed Dr Mike More who stands down as Chair of CUH in December 2024 after a total of 11 year's service on the Board as a Non-Executive Director, with eight years as Chair.
